

FY2022 Grant Program: *\$30 million in available funding in two competitive rounds*

BASIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Assist communities in bringing systems into compliance with environmental quality standards, protect public health from environmental concerns or improve the capacity and sustainability of existing infrastructure

ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Build local infrastructure capacity to support economic development activities that will lead to the creation or retention of jobs and boost opportunities for economic impact within communities

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

New construction, upgrades, improvements or extensions of publicly-owned water infrastructure, sewer infrastructure or storm water drainage facilities

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Units of Local Government, Special Purpose Districts, Public Works Commissions and Public Works Districts
(Local Governments may apply on behalf of non-profit water and sewer companies)

GRANT REQUEST

up to \$500,000

MATCH REQUIREMENTS

Projects in Tier I or II Counties:
25% of total construction costs

Projects in Tier III or IV Counties:
No match requirement on construction costs

**All applicants must pay for
100% of non-construction costs.**

Basic and Economic grants must be completed within 24 months of award.



New Grant Program!

REGIONAL FEASIBILITY PLANNING

\$1 million has been set aside in FY2022 for grants to support utilities in planning for long-term viability through regional solutions

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

Non-construction costs such as engineering, financial or other planning expenses to assess the condition of one or more systems and evaluate alternatives including regional approaches

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Same as the Basic and Economic programs

GRANT REQUEST

up to \$100,000

MATCH REQUIREMENTS

Projects in Tier I or II Counties:
25% of total project costs

Projects in Tier III or IV Counties:
No match requirement

**To submit a request, complete the
Regional Feasibility Planning
grant application.**

Regional Feasibility Planning grants must be completed within 12 months of award.
